

> DENTAL CARE AFTER PHYSICAL ABUSE - INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

You consulted a dentist today because someone injured you.

In addition to providing dental care, your dentist can also record your injuries in a special dental record that can be kept in your patient file until you need it. If you later choose to press charges, this record can be retained to present to the police and the criminal court to help prove what happened.

Your dental record can help you in many other ways. For example, you can use it to back up a claim under the law on compensation for victims (Opferentschädigungsgesetz) and to support your case if you decide to pursue civil court protection.

You do not have to deal with a difficult life situation alone!

Ask your dentist about local counseling and support services.
