



Information on test offers for employees

(As of 11/05/2021)

I. Testing

Testing for infection is an essential part of combating the spread of the dangerous Corona virus. Testing is aimed at detecting infections in good time. This directly protects everyone, and protects the health system from dangerous overloading. Despite testing, compliance with the SHM+V rule applies: maintain **S**spacing (at least 1.5 metres), observe **H**yggiene rules (proper coughing, sneezing and thorough hand washing), wear a **M**ask in everyday life and **V**entilate.

II. Test offer for employees

Employers are obliged to offer a Corona test at least twice a week to all employees in their companies who do not work exclusively in home office. Possibilities are:

- self-test,
- rapid tests carried out professionally by third parties or
- PCR tests carried out professionally by third parties.

If possible, the test offers should be taken up before starting the relevant activity.

The test **costs** are borne by your **employer**. Participation in the tests is voluntary, and a certificate can be issued.

III. Consequences for positive tests

You have been informed that you have tested **positive** for infection with SARS-CoV-2. If so, this results in immediate consequences and obligations for you. You can find information under the following link:
